## Third day

Early afternoon

All-day excursion suggestions:

- Trip to the **Black Forest**  
  
Visit **Lake Mummelsee** - 40 minutes drive from the city center of Baden-Baden, a picturesque mountain lake, 3,400 feet above sea level. Around Lake Mummelsee extensive hiking trails and bicycle lanes invite for sportive action  
  
Or  
  
Visit **Titisee** – half an hour drive from the city center, where a boat trip surrounded by the forested mountains is a must-do. Be sure to taste the delicious and world famous Black-Forest-Cake
- **Strasbourg**, the very heart of Europe and capital of Alsace is only an hour away of Baden-Baden. Enjoy a visit at the “Münster of Strasbourg” – the dome in the city centre, strolling along the charming “Petit France” quarter, take a boat trip along the River Inn or take a look at the World’s hugest cheese cover
- **Stuttgart** the capital of the State of Baden-Württemberg - 1 hour drive - offers several museums for car lovers:  
  
Visit the **Mercedes Benz Museum** and experience more than 120 years of innovative automobile history on three floors

**Basel** - only one and a half hour from Baden-Baden with the ICE high speed train - is located in northwest Switzerland, where the Swiss, French and German borders meet. Basel is among the most important cultural centres of Switzerland. The city comprises a large number of theatres and many museums, including the Museum of Fine Art, the world's oldest art collection accessible to the public

Reach Baden-Baden highest point to enjoy breathtaking views over the Rhine River Valley and the Black Forest with one of Europe's steepest funicular. A cozy restaurant at the top of the mountain invites for a delicious break
